mission of serving all children in Colorado, and also providing quality programs that spark imagination in our children.

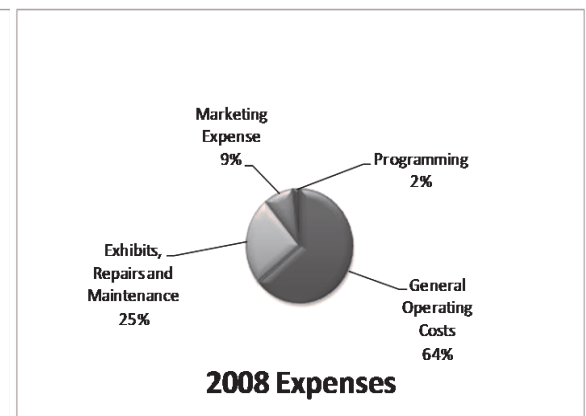
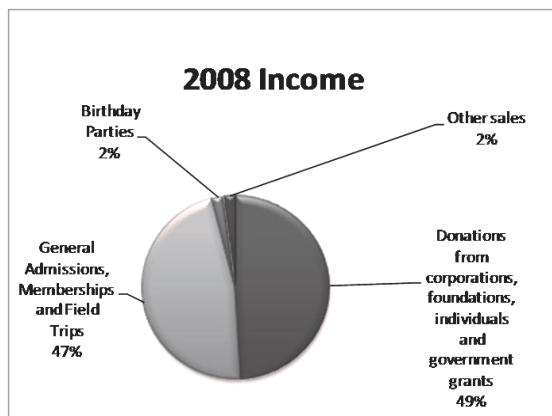

SUMMER SCIENCE CLASSES!

Interactive science classes for Pre-K (ages 3-5 years) and Grades K-2nd students. Adult participation required for all Pre-K classes. Class limit is 12 students per class.

Science of Bubbles - July 14th

Explore the nature of bubbles. Why are they round? Create bubble making instruments while learning about the science of soap!

Slime and Ooze - July 29th

Come mix up gooey concoctions in this super science class! We'll experiment with solids, liquids, and gases to see how they pop and ooze.

Science of Ice Cream - August 4th & August 5th (offered twice due to popularity!) Learn about different states of matter while discussing the process of making ice cream. We will identify the purpose of ice cream ingredients and make yummy ice cream to eat!

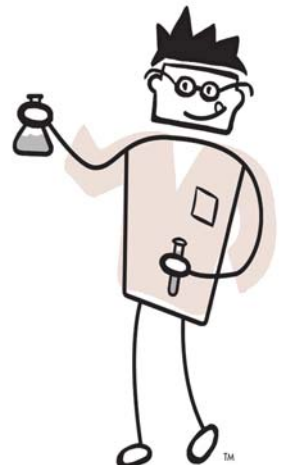

- Member Guest Rate:** \$5.50 p/child for friends/guests of members



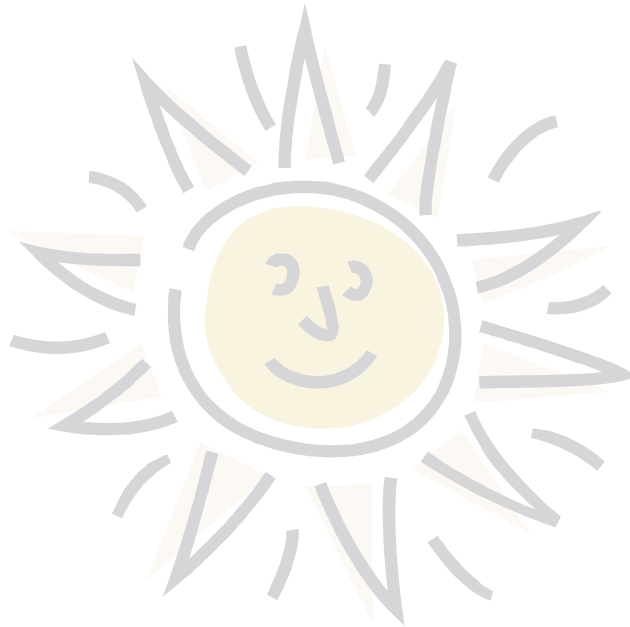
